In order to demonstrate this commitment and ongoing environmental improvements we will ensure that we meet our following objectives:

- To comply with all relevant regulations.
- To reduce material and energy consumption, solvent emissions and hazardous waste generation.
- To handle, transport, store and dispose of potentially environmentally damaging materials within the appropriate legislation and codes of practice.
- To improve efficiency of all operations to prevent pollution of the environment.
- To ensure that all employees are made aware of this policy, environmental issues and their responsibilities and are competent to meet those responsibilities through the appropriate training, communication and sharing of expertise and monitoring of the companies activities.
- To encourage an environmental awareness and responsibility of suppliers and clients through instruction and dissemination of information.
- To continue to use suppliers that have attained both FSC and PEFC Chain of Custody who promote products that are sourced from sustainable forests under the scope of the Forest Steward Council.
- To maintain a strategy for external environmental communications including making this policy publicly available.

We will implement our policies through a coordinated environmental management system in accordance with our ISO 14001 accreditation, full certification for FSC (Forest Stewardship Council) Chain of Custody, whilst print with vegetable based inks. The management hold an appraisal of our environmental performance every 12 months, and will review our environmental targets and objectives to ensure they remain appropriate.
